## II Undergraduate Colloquium on Spanish for the Health Professions

The Pre-Health Undergraduate Education group of the National Association of Medical Spanish (NAMS) invites submissions of proposals to its **Second Undergraduate Colloquium on Spanish for the Health Professions**, which will be held **virtually** on <u>November 4</u>. This year, the Colloquium will be embedded in the <u>Third Medical Spanish Summit</u> hosted by NAMS.

Undergraduate students in pre-health tracks and/or Medical Spanish programs are welcome to submit proposals addressing health topics connected to the Spanish-speaking community. The colloquium is particularly interested in topics focusing on health disparities, migrant health, and social justice. However, other approaches and perspectives are welcome as well. Recent graduates may submit proposals as well.

After the Colloquium, participants will be able to:

- 1. Have their research work in the field of undergraduate Medical Spanish shared and evaluated in a formal academic platform.
- 2. Analyze different areas connected to the study of Medical Spanish, beyond language skills, and their application to the improvement of patient care.
- 3. Participate in a community of undergraduate students/mentor that promotes interinstitutional collaborations.
